ENGLISH RUN DAY





5A Lam Ka Man, Cathy Child Poverty

In 2014, it was reported that more than 1.2 billion people in the world still live in extreme poverty, and many of these families have children. It seems that child poverty is a serious problem that affects many children in our society. The most obvious impact is on their academic performance because these children face many difficulties that make it hard for them to succeed academically. This is a discussion topic that attracts worldwide attention. In this essay, I would like to discuss the causes of this problem and suggest what the government and the schools can do to combat this problem.

There are several causes of why children who face poverty usually have poor academic performance in school. First, one of the problems that children face in poverty is that they do not have enough money to gain more educational opportunities. For example, they are unable to attend cram schools and buy some extra exercises because they don't have enough money. As a result, poor children can't get more extra knowledge from these resources. This leads to the result that poor children generally perform worse academically in school. How can we solve this problem? In my opinion, the government should provide subsidies to low-income families. The subsidies are useful to minimize their burden to buy textbooks and school uniforms. It can help them to save some money to buy some extra exercise books and attend the cram schools to gain more extra knowledge. Also, the subsidies can let them have equal learning opportunities as children from normal families. Since the educational resources are expensive, after getting the subsidies, the children from low-income families can attend the tutorial classes and buy more educational resources. In addition, in this era of technology, most learning modes have been converted to electronic learning. Thus, if the government provides subsidies to them, they can use the subsidies to buy iPads or computers for e-learning. So, their learning process will not be different from those of normal families, and they will get the fairest learning opportunities, and they will improve their academic performance at school. In conclusion, the government should provide subsidies to low-income families in order to help them to afford a lot of expenses.

Second, the next problem that children in poverty face is that they

usually feel stressed and sad, which affects their academic performance. For example, low-income families may face financial pressure that may make children need to find part-time jobs to bring home the bacon. Therefore, the children may not be able to focus on their studies because they are tired after work, causing them to feel a lot of stress and it affects their academic performance at



school. Also, poor children may have low self-esteem because of poverty. They may feel being isolated at school, which can lead to emotional distress and it also affects their academic performance. From my perspective, schools should provide free tutoring programs to poor children at school. Since they may have to spend time on their studies and part-time job at the same time, it causes their grades to be poor. If schools can provide free tuition classes which provide additional support and tutoring, it will definitely help the students to bridge any learning gaps they may have at school. For example, schools can organise study groups, group tutoring or oneon-one tutoring for them. Also, schools can provide extra educational resources to poor children. These resources can increase the poor children's learning opportunities, minimize educational gaps, and enable them to succeed academically. Students can attend these classes during lunchtime or leisure time, which can reduce their study pressure and improve their academic performance. At the same time, schools can also provide psychological counselling, and teachers can also give them more academic support. In this way, their learning performance will be better. In conclusion, schools should provide free tutoring programs and special concern to poor children in order to help them to have more opportunities to improve their grades.

To summarize, there are various causes which explain why low-income families' children usually have poor academic performance at school. But by providing subsidies and free tutoring, children can also get by equal opportunities to study as those from normal families. It seems that if we are to solve this problem, we need to combine the efforts of the government and schools to let students know there is always a silver lining. Therefore, we need to seize the opportunity to help the children who are in poverty and face poor academic performance in school.



在這次的比賽當中,我認識到一個團隊比一個人更加容易完成一件事,並且分工 在團隊當中也十分重要,因為分工可以讓一個團隊不會因為一個難題而耽誤所有的進 程, 這次的比賽使我獲益良多, 累積了許多的經驗, 並日對STREAM方面的比賽更加 有興趣。
